

# Frontiers in Low Temperature Plasma Diagnostics XII

First announcement



23 - 27 April 2017, Zlatibor, Serbia

The 12<sup>th</sup> biennial Frontiers in Low Temperature Plasma Diagnostics (FLTPD) workshop is being organised by the University of Belgrade (Faculty of Physics and Institute of Physics). This workshop is the continuation of a very successful biennial series which began in 1995 at Les Houches (France). It will be held at the beautiful Serbian mountainside of Zlatibor and will take place from Sunday 23<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 at the conference centre "Romanija".

## Conference format

FLTPD workshop is a European event which brings together scientists working on lowtemperature plasmas to present their recent results, focusing on original diagnostic techniques. The workshop is limited to approximately 80 participants from academic, research and industrial institutions. The program consists of expert presentations from around 10 invited speakers, topical talks selected by the International Scientific Committee from submitted abstracts, and poster contributions. All participants are expected to present a contribution. It is an important and fruitful opportunity for young plasma scientists to share and discuss the latest developments in plasma diagnostics with the experts in the field.

## Program

The scientific program of FLTPD will start on the morning of Monday the 24th and will finish on Thursday the 27th at noon. The workshop and poster sessions will take place in the morning and late afternoon/evening. Following the tradition of FLTPD meetings, all afternoons will be free for scientific exchange and discussions. #### Venue

FLTPD XII will take place at the conference centre "Romanija" at the mountain of Zlatibor in western Serbia. Participants will be accommodated in University Boarding house "<u>Ratko</u> <u>Mitrović</u>" in single and double rooms, two-bed and four-bed apartments.

#### Conference fee

The conference fee has been kept as low as possible (~450€ for regular participants, ~250€ for PhD students in double rooms and ~300€ for PhD students in single rooms. Conference fee includes registration, bus transport, full accommodation and meals.
